<u>11-Day Jubilee Pilgrimage to Italy departing on</u> <u>December 1, 2025, and returning on December</u> <u>11, 2025.</u> Fr. Andrew will be the host and spiritual director of an 11-day pilgrimage to Italy in December 2025 (December 1-11, 2025) visiting Venice, Florence, Assisi and Rome during the Jubilee Year 2025. The pilgrimage is being organized by Nawas International Travel Company.

A Jubilee Year is a special celebration in the Church held once every 25 years. It's a year of pilgrimages, spiritual renewals, repentance, confessions and special Masses. Customarily, Catholics can receive a "Jubilee Indulgence" during a Jubilee Year, by going to confession, receiving the Eucharist, praying for the Pope, and by making a pilgrimage either to the basilicas of Rome, to the Holy Land, or the cathedral church of a local diocese. Those who cannot make a pilgrimage can instead make a spiritual sacrifice or a work of mercy.

This pilgrimage will be an opportunity to pass through the Holy Doors of the Basilica of St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican City and the other three major Basilicas in Rome. If you might be interested in making this pilgrimage, specific details are in the brochures that are in the gathering space. Please take one, pray about it and consider making this once in a generation pilgrimage.
